

School Properties Disposition

The Board has the authority to sell any school property which may not be needed in the foreseeable future upon such terms and conditions as it may approve. If the property is sold to a state agency or political subdivision of the state, it shall not be necessary to find that the property may not be needed. Land and buildings shall be sold only upon approval of the Building Corporation Board.

The budget managers shall handle the disposal of unusable and obsolete materials and equipment in a manner most beneficial to the school. This shall include any books, equipment or supplies that are outdated, worn out or are declared surplus and no longer needed in the school.

Prior approval of the Financial Administrator shall be required before any books, equipment or supplies are sold or when any fixed assets are disposed of.
