

Instructional Resources and Materials

The Twin Peaks Charter Academy Board of Directors is responsible for the selection of all instructional materials. Twin Peaks Charter Academy Board of Directors delegates to the Twin Peaks Charter Academy curriculum committee the authority to research and recommend the instructional resources and materials, library materials, media and computer programs to be used to supplement the Core Knowledge curriculum. These instructional resources and content-rich materials will also include literary and art appreciation, and character development, and may include materials about local and state history.

Materials for the classroom texts shall be selected by the curriculum committee in consultation with the Principal, faculty and parents of the students. The final decision on the purchase shall rest with the Twin Peaks Charter Academy Board of Directors.

This policy shall serve as a guide in the selection of all instructional materials, with the curriculum committee serving as a review committee in all areas as needed.
