

### TPCA Media Viewing Permission Slip

Provided they meet specific curricular objectives, media, including movies, may occasionally be used to support the lesson. Such media will have been evaluated based on the varied interests and abilities of students, their intellectual development and maturity levels, the TPCA mission statement, and the character standards of the TPCA community. Movies will not have profane language or sexually explicit material.

This form does not refer to supplemental resources specifically produced for educational purposes such as documentaries or science and history videos.

Below are the defined categories based on the grade of the student:

K-3: Only G-rated movies may be used upon written Administrative approval.

4-5: Only G-rated movies may be used. A PG movie may be used upon written Administrative approval and the teacher will seek separate parental consent in which content for movie rating is divulged.

6-8: G and PG movies may be used. A PG-13 movie may be used upon written Administrative approval and the teacher will seek separate parental consent in which content for movie rating is divulged.

9-12: G, PG, or PG-13 movies may be used. An R movie may be used upon written Administrative approval and the teacher will seek separate parental consent in which content for movie rating is divulged.

This form will be distributed to students each year. Please return this form promptly.

My student may view all media/movies the teacher selects to support the curriculum.

My student may view certain media/movies with my permission on a case-by-case basis.

My student may never view media/movies the teacher selects to support the curriculum. I understand that my student will be provided with an alternative assignment.
