

Physical Education Credit

Twin Peaks High School requires students to complete one (1) physical education credit to graduate. These physical education credits may be earned when participation in a formal athletic program has been pre-approved and sufficient documentation is submitted.

P.E. Credits and Exemptions

- Sports earn 0.25 credits per season of the 1 credit required for graduation.
- Students who participate in CHSAA-sanctioned athletics at Twin Peaks High School will receive up to 2.0 credits of Twin Peaks High School P.E. credit.
- Students who participate in CHSAA-sanctioned athletics at other schools (when those sports are not offered at Twin Peaks High School) will receive up to 2.0 credits for P.E.
- Students who participate in a club sport outside of Twin Peaks High School will not receive any P.E. credit, if that sport is offered during the same season at Twin Peaks High School. *(An example... boys HS soccer season is the Fall, girls HS soccer season is the Spring. Boys cannot receive this credit when playing club soccer in the Fall, boys can earn the credit in the Spring. Girls cannot receive this credit when playing club soccer in the Spring, girls can earn the credit in the Fall.)*
- Students who participate in non-CHSAA sports outside of Twin Peaks High School (when that sport is not offered at Twin Peaks High School) may earn 2.0 P.E. credits.
- Hours may not be earned or logged through the summer vacation which is defined as: after the students' last day of spring semester through to the students' first day of fall semester.

Students must request credit for these athletic activities by submitting a completed Twin Peaks High School Credit for Outside Activity Form to the Athletic Director by the end of the first practice of that sport's season. All applications will be reviewed by the principal or designee. Additionally, this form must be submitted by the student each time credit is requested. No more than .5 credits of P.E. credit may be earned in this manner in any given school year.
